# Gulf Coast Kayak Fishing Tournament Rules

**Registration & Entry Fees:** Registration is currently taking place. Those that register before September 27, will receive a complimentary long sleeve specialty kayak shirt. We will be taking registrations at the Captain's Meeting October 13 if you did not pre-register by mail, by phone or in person at the Chamber in Perry. Keep in mind, those that register at the meeting are not eligible for the free shirt, but will get one if supplies allow (First come...). Registration begins at 6:00 a.m. and ends at 9:00 a.m. on the day of the tournament at Walter B's. (You can pre-register at the Chamber of Commerce Monday-Friday between 8am-4pm up until the day before the event). Entry fee is \$55.00 per person. Entry fees are non-refundable. The only exception to this is in the event that the tournament is postponed or canceled by the Tournament Director. **Each angler must fill out registration!!!**

**Hours of Competition & Check-In:** Tournament will begin at safe daylight, as determined by the Tournament Director. Safe daylight is defined as 30 minutes before sunrise. Weigh In will be from 1:00 pm until 5:00 p.m. at Walter B's (Keaton Beach Road)

**\*\*\***Tournament conclusion time will be 5:00 p.m. (All anglers must check in **either in person or by phone** with the Tournament Director and staff by this time. (Check In At WALTER B's)

Each kayaker may turn in multiple fish at check in—but you can only win once in each category. Be sure to take pictures of all your fish as you catch them so that you have a better chance of placing in one or more categories. Only turn in your longest ONE fish in each category (including the Mystery Fish and the Red with most spots)

For safety reasons it is IMPORTANT that ALL kayakers check in at the end of the tournament. If you have no fish to check-in, or if you choose not to turn in your catch, check in with the Tournament staff by radio or cell phone please.

**Tournament Rules:** In the event a tournament is canceled due to unforeseen circumstances, it may be rescheduled for the next day. The Tournament Director and Tournament Committee reserve the right to make all decisions regarding the safe operation of a tournament. **TOKENS WILL BE GIVEN TO ALL TOURNAMENT** participants at Captain Mtg.

Each entrant is responsible for the safe operation of his or her kayak and must comply with all federal and state regulations governing such operation. The use of alcohol during the tournament is prohibited.

**IMPORTANT-Captain's Meeting:** The Captain's meeting will be held at the Walter B's (Keaton Beach Road, Perry) on October 12th at 6:00 p.m. Captain's Bags will be given out, first come. Each kayaker represented at the Captain's Meeting will earn an additional **.25 inch bonus added to their trout or redfish!** Also the **"MYSTERY FISH"** of the Tournament will be revealed...so be sure to attend the **CAPTAIN'S MTG.!** Steak/Shrimp Dinner purchase available \$18 Pre-Order!!
